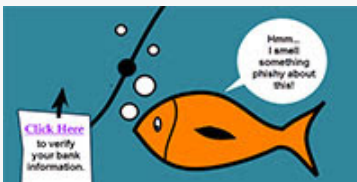




## Connected learning: Future teachers learning from our current students

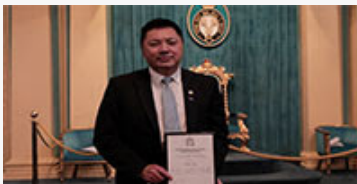
### Nishar wins RSV Award
